State testing is upon us! This communication contains pertinent information that all families need to be aware of as it pertains to April 2nd – April 11th.

Who is testing and on what dates?

- April 2nd ACT for Juniors no school for all other grades.
- April 4th AZScience for Juniors late start for all other grades.
- April 9th ACT Aspire for Freshmen no school for all other grades.
- April 11th Pre-ACT for Sophomores late start for all other grades.

The tests begin promptly at 8:20 am for every group so it is pertinent that students arrive at campus on time. Room assignments for each student will be posted in the front office, outside of the cafeteria, and in the hallways starting Monday, April 1st.

My student is going to be absent on a date they are supposed to test, what happens?

It is incredibly important that students are here on the assigned testing dates! Students who are ill should stay home and they will be pulled to make up their test at a later date. Please be sure to call the attendance line and excuse your student. If your student has a pre-scheduled appointment and can only complete a portion of the test should stay home and complete the test in its entirety at a later date.

- Students cannot start the exam and resume it at a later time so they should plan on being here for the entire testing time on each date.
- Once testing begins, the front office will not be allowed to call students out of classrooms and interrupt the testing session so please note that students will not be able to leave once testing has begun.

What do students need to bring on testing days?

- A charged campus-issued laptop
- Laptop charger
- Student ID or State ID
- An ACT-permitted calculator (see attached document for specifications)
- Water and Snacks
- Students with the appropriate accommodations should bring headphones if possible (non-Bluetooth that can plug into a computer jack)

What items are prohibited for students to have during the tests?

- Cell phones
- Smart Watches
- Personal laptops, tablets, or other devices

^{*}All electronics that are not to be utilized during testing will be turned off and collected by test administrators until the end of the assessment.

*Please note that electronics may not be accessed at any time during the test. This includes breaks! Devices that activate, ring, alert, or are accessed during the testing time will result in the student being dismissed and their test will not be scored.

How can I help ensure my student is prepared?

- Ask your students to charge and bring their laptops as well as their chargers to school each day from March 27th through April 14th.
- Ensure that your student arrives at campus on time! Students who are late will not be permitted to test and alternative arrangements will have to be made.
- Have your students restart their laptops the night before testing.
- For the ACT, ensure your student has filled out their MyACT profile. This will allow them to receive a free copy of their scores and have their score reports sent to four colleges for free.

When will my student receive their scores?

- ACT Students Students who complete the MyACT profile on Wednesday, March 27th will receive a copy of their scores up to 8 weeks after testing. Students who have not completed their profile will not receive a copy.
- All others will receive a paper copy of their scores once they are received by the campus over the summer.
